Castearo

The "Castearo" is a typical example of the Muscat wine. Originally from Greece, it belongs to the great family of Muscat and in the Colli Euganei it has preserved its true identity.

A wine that has an aromatic scent yet a dry taste. With its straw yellow colour and green hues, it welcomes us with freshness, youthful. It has a fragrant impact, distinctive and clean so characteristic of Muscat yet without depriving it of its eloquent properties of fragrant herbs, exotic fruit, citrus, fine spices, William pears. A slightly rounded finale of freshness with a dry undertone, vegetal, refreshing.
