

COLLI EUGANEI DOC PINOT BIANCO

Marani

This grape variety is a genetic mutation of Pinot Nero. Its origins are ancient and aristocratic. Very popular in France (Burgundy), where it is believed to have originated, it has been long confused with Chardonnay with whom it shares similar characteristics.

Our *terroir* predetermines the pale yellow colour of this wine with its fruity and floral aromas which hint of yellow apples, banana, green peppers, almonds, citrus and aromatic herbs. Savoury, balanced, full bodied, lingering flavour.
